The Schools.

Avon High School... continues to set records in arts, athletics, and academics. 80% Avon graduates attend college. 86% received Core 40 diplomas. Avon's Band, the Marching Black & Gold, were the Indiana State Class A Band Champions for the 7th year in a row! New freshmen teaming programs are in place. Plans are underway for the new Avon Advanced Learning Center (12th Grade Center) slated to open Fall 2010. Students are taught the importance of academic excellence, critical thinking, and communication skills required for the 21st century.

Avon Middle South... program is a perfect representation of a middle school philosophy.
